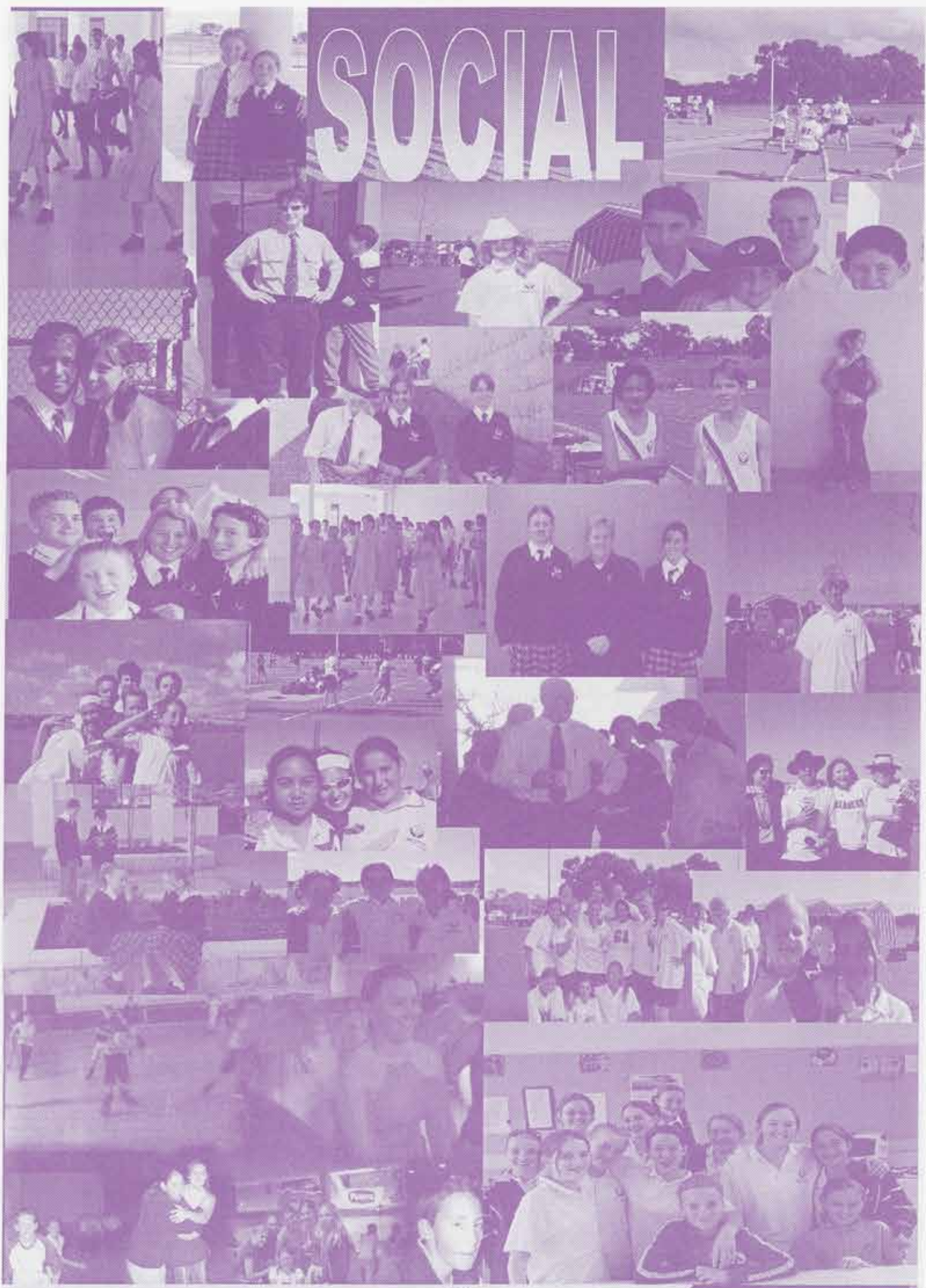


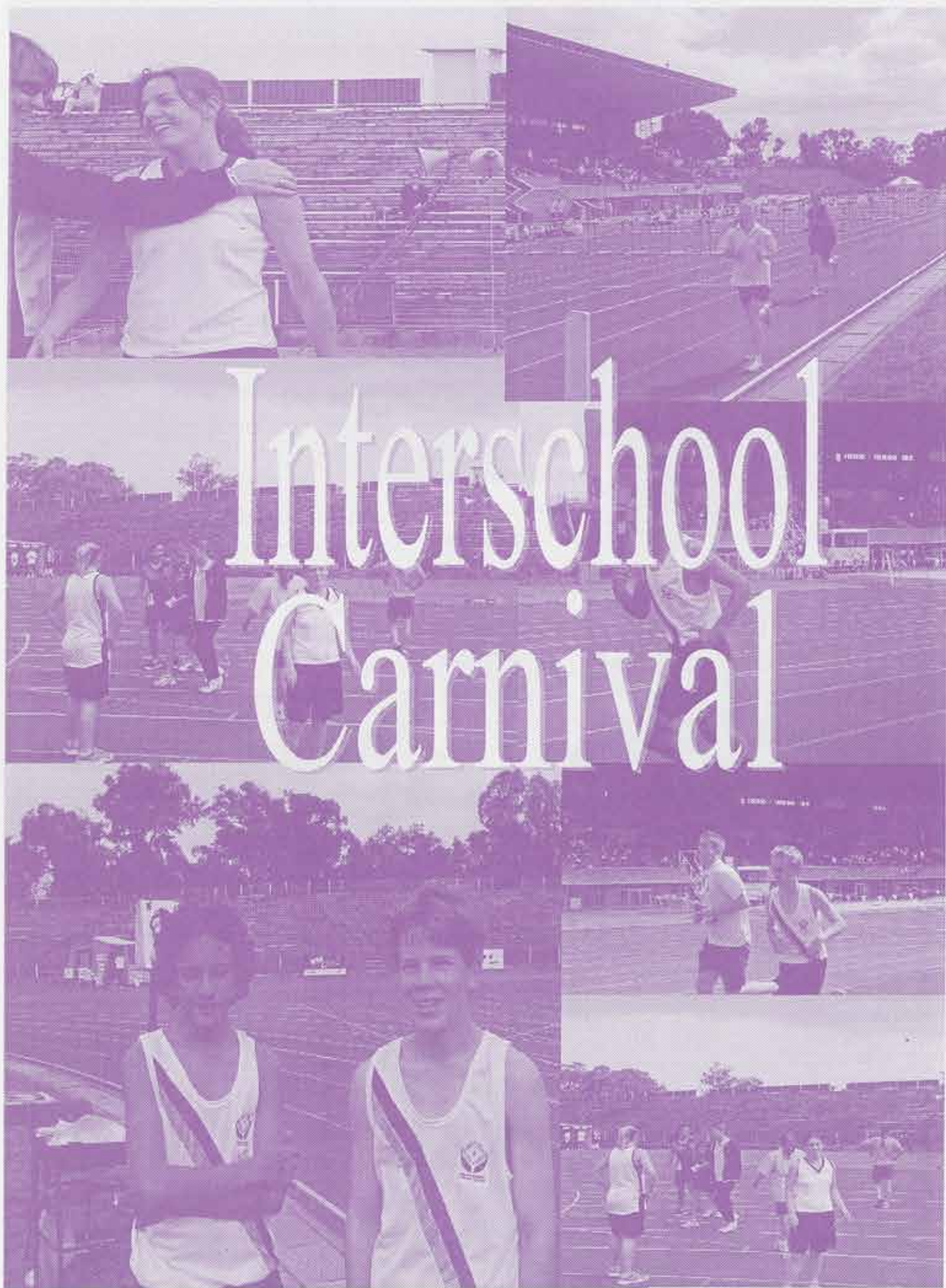
Community Involvement

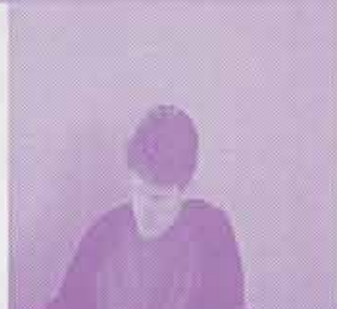

teacher blow up a hydrogen balloon. **What is the funniest incident that has happened in the science room?** Watching someone drop flour all over their desk.

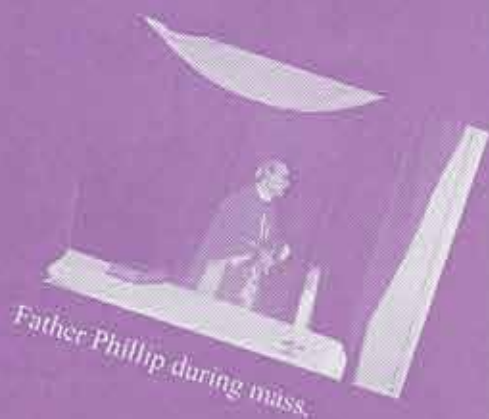

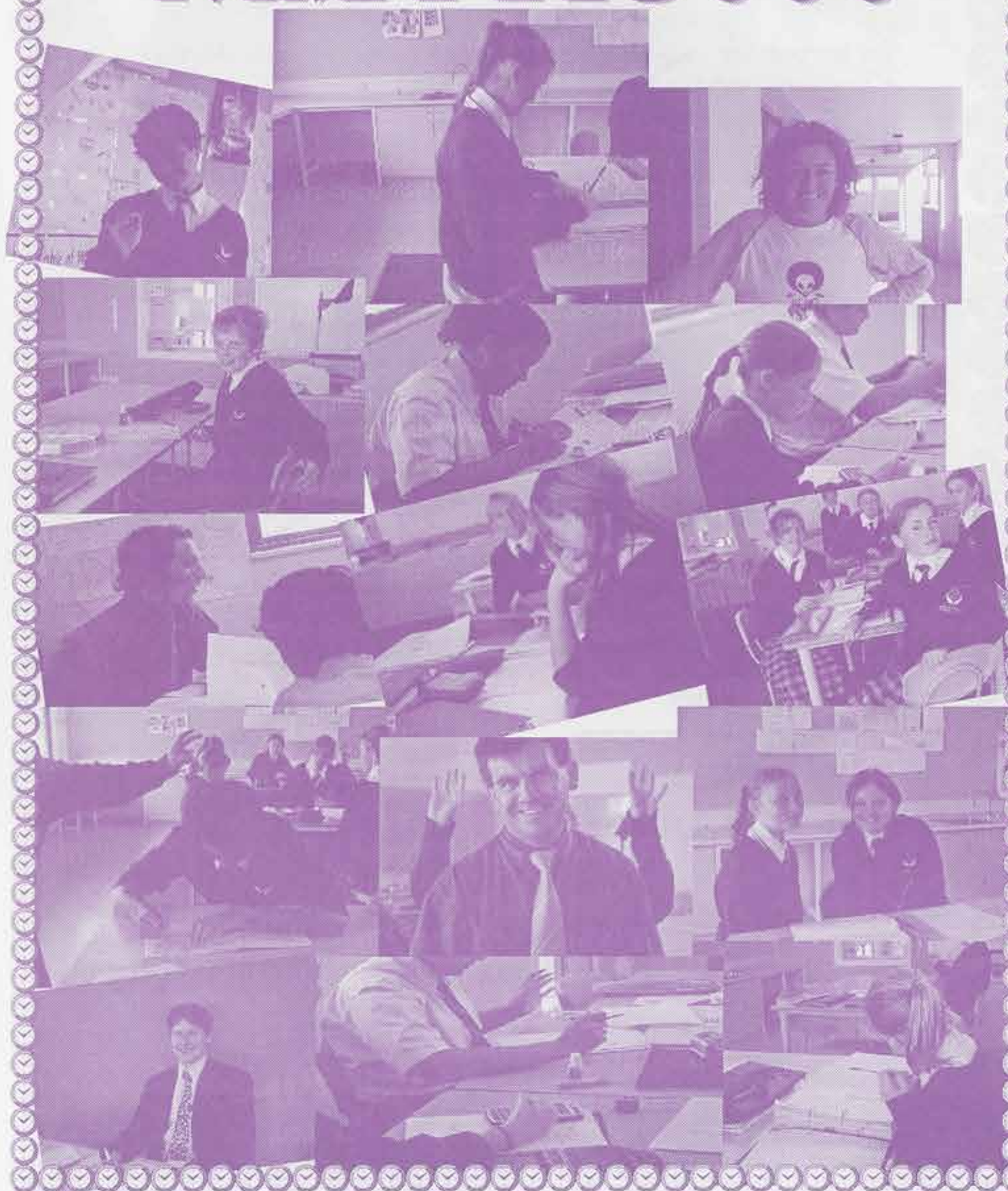
