COVID-19 Update

Vaccinations

All Western Australians aged 12 and over are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine. Information on WA's Vaccination Program can be found on the [Healthy WA](#) website. The WA Government would like all Year 12 students to be vaccinated ahead of their end of year exams and leavers' week. Their plan is that all Year 11 and Year 12 students will get priority access to the Pfizer vaccine through government-run clinics. We are awaiting further direction and clarity from Department of Health and will provide this as soon as possible.

Vaccination is now open for Western Australians aged 12-16 at all State-run vaccination clinics. Bookings are essential. Parents and guardians can register their children as a dependant under their account and book them an appointment by visiting [Roll up for WA](#).

All eligible Western Australians are encouraged to get the COVID-19 vaccine.

Interstate Travel

If there is consideration for students to travel interstate for any reason, could you please contact your son or daughter's Year level Assistant Deputy Principal. Appropriate arrangements need to be in place should circumstances change and they are required to hotel/self-quarantine on return to Western Australia, or are unable to re-enter the state.
