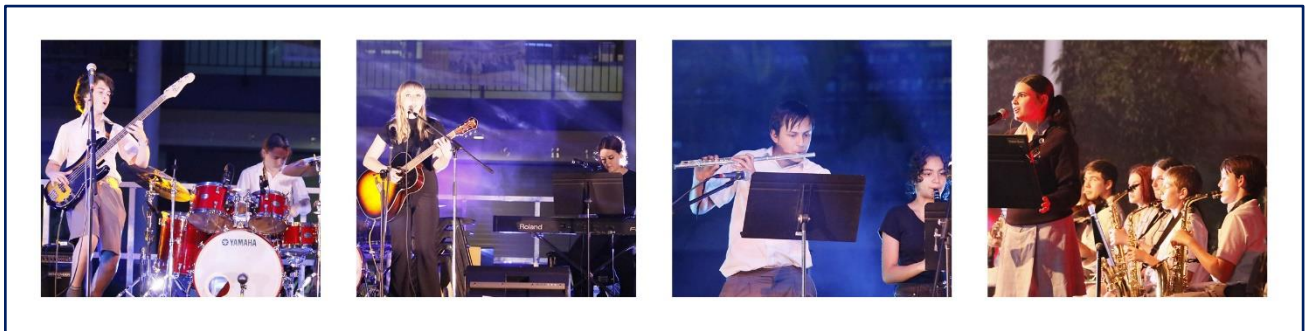

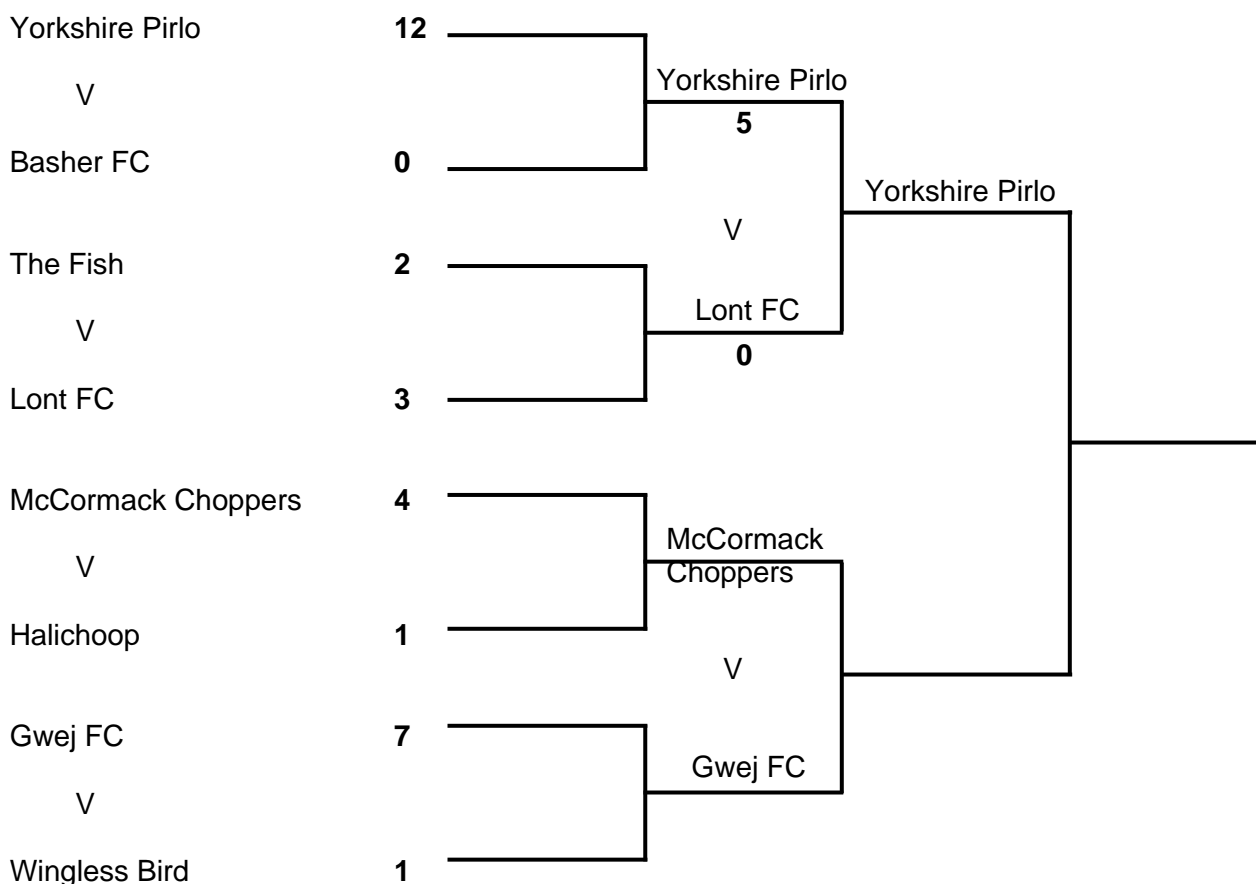
Eligible families must apply for the discount through their primary school.
