Principal Announcement

Dear Parents and other members of the College Community

I am writing to inform you that I will conclude my time as Principal of our College at the end of this year.

Since commencing in the role of 2014, I have valued being a member of the College community and working with the talented students, families, and our dedicated staff to provide quality Catholic education.

A comprehensive process to appoint a new Principal for Irene McCormack Catholic College from January next year will be conducted by Catholic Education WA in collaboration with the College Advisory Council with Chair, Mr Gavan Prunster. The process will commence this week with a view to being completed and a new Principal announced by mid-September. There will be opportunities for some involvement in this process by members of the Irene McCormack community.

Covid-19 Requirements

All students are to be complimented with observing the requirement to wear masks. They must continue to be worn in all classrooms, other indoor areas at school and on public transport. It is hoped that this requirement is only in force until Wednesday.

As a reminder for observing Covid 19 requirements:

- A Students who has flu or cold symptoms must stay at home and seek medical advice about having a Covid19 test.
- A student must stay at home if advised to do so by Health Authorities.
- A Student must stay at home if they, or a member of their household, requires a Covid19 test. They are to stay at home until they, or the household member, returns a negative Covid19 test result.
- Parents are requested to inform me if students are travelling interstate at any time.
