Special Edition – Covid-19 Update – Monday, 28 June 2021 - 9.30pm

Good evening,

At 8:15 pm tonight the Premier announced a 4-day lockdown for the Perth and Peel region commencing at midnight tonight. This follows a further case of community spread reported this evening.

Key messages:

- The College will be open tomorrow, Tuesday 29th June.
- Parents may choose to keep their children at home, as with the previous lockdowns.
- We expect a number of staff, parents and students have been at exposure sites in recent days and will be required to have a Covid test and remain at home until a negative result has been confirmed. As a consequence students need to be ready for some combined classes and change of classrooms tomorrow.
- Students who have flu or cold symptoms must stay at home and seek medical advice about having a Covid19 test.
- Masks must be worn inside and outside.
